POLAR CIRCLE QUEST

Expedition cruise to the Malvinas, South Georgia, Antarctic Peninsula & South Shetland Islands aboard the USHUAIA

- King Penguins, the majestic Wandering Albatrosses, breeding ground for elephant and fur seals.

The Malvinas and South Georgia are home to hundreds of thousands of albatrosses and penguins, including the King Penguin, as well as seals and whales. This along with spectacular scenery and the fascinating history of the early explorers, especially Sir Ernest Shackleton, make for a truly memorable trip.

THE USHUAIA

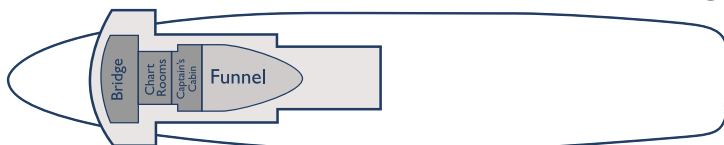
The ice-strengthened polar vessel **USHUAIA** is the ideal expedition ship for Antarctica. Public areas feature a large dining room (one sitting), an observation lounge and bar, library, a conference room with modern multimedia equipment and a small infirmary. Our chefs prepare excellent cuisine including many local specialties and the bar is well-stocked with carefully selected wines and spirits.

Originally built for the United States agency **NOAA** (National Oceanic & Atmospheric Administration), the **USHUAIA** has been refurbished to accommodate a maximum of 90 passengers in 46 comfortable cabins and suites.

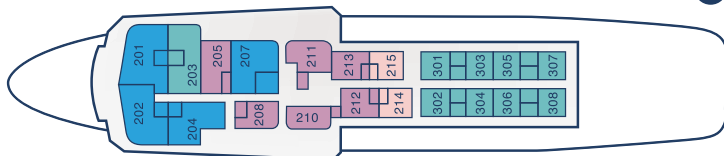

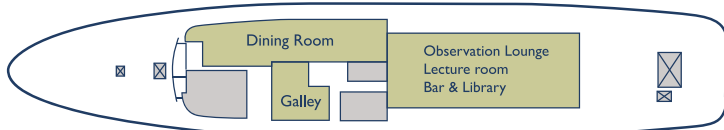
BRIDGE DECK **H**



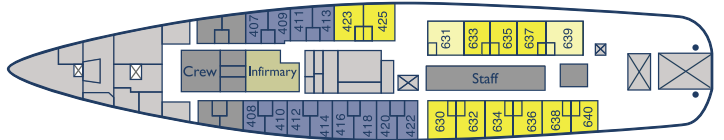
UPPER DECK **G**

ACCOMMODATION

Suites: 4 Outside cabins with windows on the upper deck G, private facilities, two lower berths, lounge, TV, DVD player and fridge. Suite 201 features two double beds, Suite 202 one double bed and a sofa bed. Suites 204 and 207 feature three lower single beds.

Superior: 9 Twin outside cabins with windows on the upper deck G, private facilities, two lower berths. Cabin 301 has one double and one single bed.

Premier: 6 Twin outside cabins with windows on the upper deck G, private facilities, two lower berths; 2 Single cabins with portholes (view obstructed by lifeboat) on the upper deck G, private facilities.

Standard Plus: 11 Twin outside cabins with portholes or windows on deck E, private facilities, two lower berths. Cabin 640 has one double bed. 2 Triple outside cabins with portholes or windows on deck E, private facilities, three lower berths.

Standard: 12 Twin outside cabins with portholes on deck E, semi-private facilities, two berths (upper/lower).

N.B. Semi-private facilities: Two cabins share one bathroom accessible from both cabins (shower and WC). Each cabin is also equipped with its own washbasin.



A TRIP OF A LIFETIME

Antarctica is the most pristine, exhilarating and beautiful place that you can imagine and is perhaps the last true wilderness area left on Earth - largely unchanged since explorers and whalers first landed on its inhospitable shores less than two centuries ago. Antarctica is the coldest, windiest, driest and highest continent. It has the longest days and surprisingly, the world's greatest concentration of wildlife.

We operate all our expeditions in accordance with IAATO guidelines and we comply with all the relevant international regulations during navigation and shore visits.

Embarking and disembarking in the port of Ushuaia, Argentina, our expeditions include many of the highlights of the Antarctic Peninsula and the South Shetland Islands. Enjoy comfortable accommodation, ample deck space, an open bridge policy, and spacious public areas. We endeavor to make at least two landings per day in the area of the peninsula, with a visit to at least one of the scientific stations to understand the work taking place in Antarctica.

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SEASONS IN THE ANTARCTIC PENINSULA & SUB-ANTARCTIC ISLANDS

Antarctic wildlife is at its most active during the southern summer. The beauty and solitude of Antarctic seas and mountains conceals the frantic activity of the shoreline colonies of birds and mammals. In this five-month period, from end of October to March, we operate our expedition cruises aboard the USHUAIA.

October

In the Malvinas and South Georgia spring and summer arrive earlier than in the South Shetlands & the Antarctic Peninsula and consequently the breeding activities of seabirds and sea mammals start earlier there. South Georgia is home to several birds with a cycle longer than one year, so eggs and young in King Penguin colonies can always be found from November to March.

November - December (spring – early summer)

- Crabeater seals are born between September and November
- Elephant seals guard their harems aggressively until December
- The first big whales come down to Antarctica to feed, among them humpback, Minke and southern right whale
- Amazing displays of the penguins' courtship ritual, including nest building, sky pointing and stone stealing
- Penguin, petrel and cormorant eggs are laid in November and December
- Penguin chicks start to hatch at the end of December in the South Shetland Islands
- Wintering scientists at the research stations welcome the first visitors of the season
- Longest days in December create longer daylight hours – photographs can be taken at midnight!
- Last winters sea-ice offers sometimes spectacular sailing among the floes with seals everywhere on the ice

January – February (summer)

- Fur seal and leopard seal pups are visible
- Whale watching is at its best in February
- Penguin colonies at their busiest, fetching krill and feeding chicks
- In February receding ice allows exploration further south along the Antarctic Peninsula
- Concentration of fur seals increases

March (autumn)

- Penguin chicks are in their adolescent state now and quite curious about visitors
- The adult penguins moult and the young go to sea
- Receding ice allows exploration farthest south along the Antarctic Peninsula
- Spectacular green and pink algae blooms on snow-slopes and ice cliffs
- Whale watching is still very good
- Wonderful sunrises and sunsets
